David Van Reybrouck is a pioneering advocate of participatory democracy. He founded the G1000 Citizens' Summit, and his work has led to trials in participatory democracy throughout the Netherlands, Belgium and France. He is also one of the most highly regarded literary and political writers of his generation and the author of *Congo: The Epic History of a People*, which won 19 prizes and has been translated into a dozen languages.

Sarah Monaghan is a widely known spokesperson and head of communications for the "Together for Yes Campaign" in the referendum that led to the legalization of abortion in Ireland in 2018. Sarah was responsible for the successful mobilization of villages and towns across Ireland, creating regional groups and

collaborative cells. Currently, she is the manager of the so-called "Consent project", which continues to work on protecting the rights of raped and molested women.
